### Sant'Anna di Vinadio automizes end of line handling

One of Europe's largest and most modern bottling facilities for mineral water has recently installed a end of line transport system with LGVs by Elettric 80. The new automatic system at Italian Sant'Anna di Vinadio meets all the latest requirements to handle finished goods warehousing/shipping with Laser Guided Vehicles. The system is controlled by a WMS (Warehouse Management System) that tracks the product from palletising to the shipping. Before the new system was up and running, the cost for manually handling pallets was approximately €500.000 a year.



The plant produces water bottles (from 0,5 to 2 l) and the maximum shipping rate is 8 trucks per hour. The maximum production rate is 180 pallets per hour. According to Elettric 80's Project Manager, Andrea Pergolizzi, the biggest challenge was to handle 3 pallets at a time with the possibility to stack three levels in the warehouse.

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### Fruit juice take the Freeway

J Garcia Carrion, one of Spain's leading producers of wines, fruit juices and natural vegetable soups has decided to adopt the Elettric 80 Freeway system at the Cítricos del Andarax plant. Freeway, which integrates robotic palletizers with Laser Guided Vehicles (LGV's), will supply J Garcia Carrion with an end of line solution that allows the company to efficiently meet the increasing market demands.

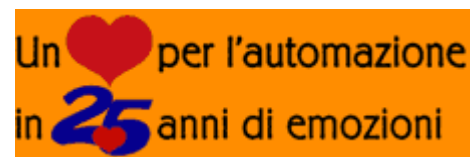


The Freeway system presents several important advantages compared to traditional more conveyor based solutions. The robotic system enables a high degree of flexibility in pack pattern configuration and the integration with the LGVs gives a cleaner more accessible layout with less conveyors. This is especially interesting when handling food and beverages where hygiene is important.

The Freeway system keep track of the product data from the respective line

to the warehouse.
